

CITY COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
DECEMBER 12, 2016

City Council met in regular session on Monday, December 12, 2016 in Council Chambers, City Hall, Lock Haven, Pennsylvania. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Mayor William Baney who opened the meeting with a moment of silence followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll was called and present were Council members Jonathan Bravard, Douglas Byerly, Richard Conklin, Ted Forbes, Steve Stevenson, Sara Stringfellow, and Mayor William Baney. Also attending the meeting were City Manager Richard Marcinkevage, Assistant City Manager Gregory Wilson, Diane Whitaker, Ross Library, and reporter Wendy Stiver for The Express.

COUNCIL MINUTES

On a motion of Mr. Conklin, seconded by Mr. Stevenson and carried unanimously, Council approved the minutes of the meeting of November 28, 2016 and December 5, 2016.

PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD

Mrs. Whitaker presented a report of the 2016 Ross Library activities and the request for 2017 funding in the amount of \$28,000.00.

CORRESPONDENCE

Comcast CATV

The Manager acknowledged receipt of a memo from Comcast CATV outlining changes in programming.

Keystone Central Tax Office

The Manager acknowledged receipt of the November Earned Income Tax in the amount of \$61,785.37 from the Keystone Central Tax Office.

Public Hearing / 2017 Recommended Budget

The Mayor stated the purpose of the public hearing was to afford the public an opportunity to comment and make observations on the 2017 recommended budget. There was no comment or observations made by City agencies, City Council or others in attendance.

OLD BUSINESS

The Manager presented second reading of an ordinance amending the Parking Ordinance to address STOP intersections on Myrtle Street and on temporary haul road at East Walnut Street; to restrict parking on Bellefonte Avenue and on Spruce Drive and Third Street to align On Street and Off Street parking enforcement procedures.

The Manager stated that there are two revisions from the First Reading of the Ordinance that was presented on December 5, 2016. The first revision removed the rates from being listed in the ordinance; and the other revision changed the boot installation from five to 10 unsettled parking violations.

On a motion by Mr. Conklin and seconded by Mr. Forbes, and carried unanimously, Council approved the second reading of an ordinance amending the parking ordinances to address STOP intersections on Myrtle Street and on temporary haul road at East Walnut Street; to restrict parking on Bellefonte Avenue and on Spruce Drive and Third Street to align On Street and Off Street parking enforcement procedures.
