ORDINANCE NO. 963

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 670, CHAPTER 15, REGULATING TRAFFIC AND PARKING IN THE CITY OF LOCK HAVEN, IMPOSING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Lock Haven, Clinton County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by authority of the same as follows:

SECTION I. Ordinance 670, Chapter 15, Part 2, Section 209, STOP Intersections Established, is hereby amended as follows:

Add: "Myrtle Street at SEDA-COG Joint Rail Authority railroad tracks, Eastbound"

Add: "Temporary haul road adjacent to East side of SEDA-COG Joint Rail Authority railroad tracks at East Walnut Street, Northbound"

SECTION II. Ordinance 670, Chapter 15, Part 4, Section 402, Parking prohibited at all times in certain locations, is hereby amended as follows:

Delete:

<u>Street</u>	<u>Side</u>	<u>Between</u>
Bellefonte Avenue	North	Commerce Street and North Jones Street
Bellefonte Avenue	North	East Park Street and West Park Street, as posted
Bellefonte Avenue	North	Willards Alley and West Park Street

Add:

<u>Street</u>	<u>Side</u>	<u>Between</u>
Bellefonte Avenue	North	Willards Alley and City Line
Spruce Drive cul de sac	All	Spruce Drive and Spruce Drive (Entire curb length of cul de sac West end of Spruce Drive)

SECTION III. Ordinance 670, Chapter 15, Part 4, Section 403, Parking prohibited in certain locations, certain days and hours, is hereby amended as follows:

Add:

<u>Street</u>	<u>Side</u>	<u>Between</u>	<u>Days</u>	<u>Hours</u>
Third Street	East	Jordans Alley and West Water Street	School Days	12PM-3PM

SECTION IV. Ordinance 670, Chapter 15, Part 5, Section 505, Coin Deposit in Meter; Overtime Parking Unlawful, is hereby amended as follows:

Add:

Section 15-505. Coin deposit in meter; overtime parking prohibited.

Whenever a vehicle is to be parked in any space adjacent to a parking meter, at any time in the period of limited parking as prescribed by § 15-502, the driver of the vehicle, upon entering the parking space, shall immediately deposit, or cause to be deposited, in that parking meter one or more proper coins of the United States of America as specified in the legend on the parking meter. Upon the deposit of the coin or coins, and placing the meter in operation, the parking space may be lawfully occupied by the vehicle for the time indicated on the meter. If any vehicle shall remain in any such parking space for any length of time that the meter shall indicate by proper signal that the lawful parking time has expired, that vehicle shall be considered as having been parked overtime, and the parking of a vehicle overtime shall be a violation of this article. Provided, every hour that a vehicle remains parked at a meter showing a violation shall constitute a separate violation of this part.

SECTION V. Ordinance 670, Chapter 15, Part 5, Section 501, Parking Meter Zones Established, is hereby amended as follows:

Column labeled "Rate"

Amend:

"Parking Meter Zones are established upon and along certain streets in the City as follows:

To Read:

"Parking Meter Zones are established upon and along certain streets in the City as listed below. Parking meter fees shall be at the rate(s) set from time to time by Council by Resolution."

SECTION VI. Ordinance 670, Chapter 15, Part 6, Section 601, Metered Parking Lots Established, as amended, is hereby amended as follows:

Column labeled "Rate"

Add:

To Paragraph labeled as 15-601, 1.,

"Parking meter fees shall be at the rate(s) set from time to time by Council by Resolution."

SECTION VII. Ordinance 670, Chapter 15, Part 6, Section 613(B), Parking Permits, as amended, is hereby amended as follows:

Delete:

Existing Section 15-613 - B

Add:

New Section 15-613 – B as follows:

"B. Permits will be issued for the lots listed below. Permit fees shall be at the rate(s) set from time to time by Council by Resolution and shall be valid for the entire calendar month for which it was issued:

- (a) Lot No. 1 (Lower Church Street lot).
- (b) Lot No. 2 (Upper Church Street lot).
- (c) Lot No. 3 (Water Street lot).
- (d) Lot No. 4 (City Hall parking lot).
- (e) Lot No. 5 (Beach parking lot).

Permits may be purchased on a monthly, quarterly or yearly basis. Permits for the subsequent year can only be purchased during the month of December of the preceding year."

SECTION VIII. Ordinance 841 of 2009 is hereby amended as follows:

Delete:

Existing Section 15-413.2.

Add:

Section 15-413.2. Boot Installation. A motor vehicle found to be parked within the City of Lock Haven upon any public ground, may, by or under direction of the Manager or his designee, be booted if there are ten (10) or more unsettled parking violations or two (2) or more unsettled citations or one (1) or more arrest warrants pending against the owner of the motor vehicle, as the result of parking violations previously issued and pending.

SECTION IX. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.

SECTION X. This ordinance shall become effective twenty (20) days after final passage unless there is passed a resolution in accordance with Section 608(b) of the Optional Third Class City Charter Law accelerating the effective date.
