AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 328 SEWERS AND SEWAGE DISPOSAL
ARTICLE II SEWER RENTAL CHARGES OF THE CITY CODE.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Lock Haven, County of Clinton, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, that the sections of Chapter 328 Sewers and Sewage Disposal Article II Sewer Rental Charges of the City Code are amended as follows:

328-8.A. Rents.

(1) The sewer rent for collection of sanitary sewage discharged into the sewer system shall be quarterly rent based upon the actual volume of water metered per quarter as determined from meters installed and maintained by the City of Lock Haven and the Suburban Lock Haven Water Authority. The minimum quarterly rent for each meter property shall be **in an amount as established from time to time by resolution of City Council** ~~\$17.70 per quarter~~, and rents will be charged ~~in accordance with the following schedule~~ **in an amount as established from time to time by resolution of City Council**:

- (a) ~~Up to 4,000 gallons per quarter: \$41.40 flat rate.~~
- (b) ~~Next 6,000 gallons per quarter: \$6.20 per 1,000 gallons.~~
- (c) ~~Next 15,000 gallons per quarter: \$6.59 per 1,000 gallons.~~
- (d) ~~Next 35,000 gallons per quarter: \$6.06 per 1,000 gallons.~~
- (e) ~~Next 140,000 gallons per quarter: \$6.29 per 1,000 gallons.~~
- (f) ~~Next 100,000 gallons per quarter: \$5.12 per 1,000 gallons.~~
- (g) ~~Next 700,000 gallons per quarter: \$4.54 per 1,000 gallons.~~
- (h) ~~All over 1,000,000 gallons per quarter: \$3.78 per 1,000 gallons.~~

328-9.D. Charges for treatment of hauled waste shall be based on the category of waste discharged and shall be billed monthly.

(1) The amounts charged shall be based on the number of gallons of waste discharged in the month and shall be **in an amount as established from time to time by resolution of City Council** ~~based on the following rates~~:

- (a) ~~Septic tank waste: \$30/1,000 gallons.~~
- (b) ~~Holding tank and trucked domestic waste:~~
 - [1] ~~First 5,000 gallons: \$5/1,000 gallons.~~
 - [2] ~~Next 50,000 gallons: \$3.50/1,000 gallons.~~
 - [3] ~~Next 50,000 gallons: \$2.50/1,000 gallons.~~
 - [4] ~~Over 105,000 gallons: \$1.50/1,000 gallons.~~
- (c) ~~Portable toilet waste: \$40.54/1,000 gallons.~~
- (d) ~~Commercial waste: \$30/1,000 gallons.~~

328-9.E. Owners of recreation vehicles shall be permitted to discharge sanitary sewage into the system and such discharge will only be made at the treatment plant. A fee of ~~€~~\$3 shall be charged for each and every time sewage is accepted for discharge to the system and shall be paid at the time of discharge to the treatment plant attendant **in an amount as established from time to time by resolution of City Council.**

BE IT FURTHER ENACTED AND ORDIANED that any ordinance conflicting with this ordinance be and the same is hereby repealed insofar as the same affects this ordinance.
