


**BY ORDER OF THE CHIEF OF THE POLICE**  
**DECEMBER 9, 2020**  
**TEMPORARY PARKING REGULATIONS**

WHEREAS, Under Section 380-4 of the City Code (Ordinance 999), City Council has enabled the Chief of Police to establish temporary parking regulations in a State of Emergency.

I NOW ORDER THAT parking is prohibited at any on-street metered parking space with a city-issued sign designating it as "Reserved for Curbside Pickup" in the Central Business District and Bellefonte Avenue except for the specific purpose of picking up goods at the business to which the sign is assigned.

Under Section 380-4 of the City Code, failure to abide by this Order shall constitute a violation and shall be subject to a fine of not more than \$25, together with the cost of prosecution.

This Order shall become effective December 9, 2020 and remain in effect until otherwise ended by my Order or upon the repeal of the State of Emergency declared by City Council on January 31, 2021.
