



ATTENTION LANDLORDS AND TENANTS! HAS THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC IMPACTED YOUR FINANCES?

EMERGENCY RENTAL AND UTILITY ASSISTANCE HELP IS HERE!

In March, Clinton County was awarded \$2,540,838 in federal Emergency Rental Assistance (ERA) funds through the Consolidated Appropriations Act of 2021.

Applications are now being accepted—don't miss this opportunity!

If you are behind in rent, water, electricity, sewer, trash removal, or heating fuel payments, and if you can prove you have losses due to the Covid-19 pandemic, you may be eligible for any or all of the following:

- Rental arrears for up to 12 months for past due rent that has been accrued after March 13, 2020.
- Future rent payments up to three months.
- Utilities and home energy costs that are directly related to the occupancy of the rental property.
- Other expenses related to housing such as relocation expenses, rental fees, late fees, etc.

Landlords—you can apply too! You can help your tenants stay in place and recover your losses through this program.
