

RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR ZINDEL PARK USE

- 1) There are no restroom facilities or running water.
- 2) There is no electricity.
- 3) Alcohol is prohibited.
- 4) Fires are prohibited.
- 5) Visitors and guests must be kept away from the small dam and the water pool in the interest of safety.
- 6) We mow the area and clean up any debris. However, we do not maintain the area in a “park like” manner, so you may want to look the area over beforehand and go in beforehand to mow the grass lower.
- 7) You can obtain keys from the Water Office in City Hall to look at the area, get in to do mowing, cleanup, and for access during the ceremony. Keys must be signed out. You can contact them at (570) 893-5909 to arrange to sign keys out. There will be a \$25 deposit for the keys, and if the keys are not returned you will forfeit the deposit.
- 8) The area must be cleaned of any trash upon leaving after the ceremony.
- 9) We do not allow use of tents or shelters on the property.
- 10) You must sign a Use Request Form prior to getting final permission for use. That can be signed when keys are picked up.
- 11) There will be a \$25 Administrative Fee for use of the park, which must be paid before the keys will be provided. This is in addition to the \$25 deposit for the keys.

If you are agreeable to the above conditions and definitely want to proceed, please send us a letter confirming that, and we will check the availability and list your activity.

We will provide a copy of this letter to the Wayne Township Supervisors, to confirm that they are aware of your use of the property.
