# CITY OF LOCK HAVEN CLINTON COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA ORDINANCE NO. 2023-09

# AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CERTAIN SECTIONS OF CHAPTER 380 VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC

Be it ordained by the City Council of Lock Haven that the following sections of Chapter 380 Vehicles and Traffic shall be amended as follows:

## § 380-10 **Speed limits.**

A. A M[m]aximum speed limits of 25 miles per hour is are established on portions of specified all city streets, street extensions, avenues, circles, drives, lanes, roads, terraces and views with the exception of the as follow[s]ing, and it shall be unlawful for any person to drive a vehicle on any part of a municipally owned lane of traffic street where a maximum speed limit applies at a higher speed than the maximum prescribed for that part of the street:

### B. A maximum speed limit of 15 miles per hour is established for all city alleys.

CB. Any person who violates any provision of this section shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of \$35 \$50.00 and costs. Any person exceeding the maximum speed limit by more than five miles per hour shall pay an additional fine of \$2 \$5.00 per mile for each mile in excess of five miles per hour over the maximum speed limit.

## § 380-12 Traffic control signals.

A. At the following locations, traffic signals as indicated below shall be erected (or are ratified if previously erected), and traffic at those locations shall be directed by those signals: [Amended 11-8-2021 by Ord. No. 2021-09]

A. Parking shall be prohibited at all times in the following locations:
