

PUBLIC WORKS >>> How to be a good neighbor in the winter

Whenever there is a snow storm, the city's main priority is getting snow off the streets! It can be frustrating when a snow plow causes snow to block a driveway. In order to prevent that from happening:

Clear an area along the shoulder, about 10 ft from the entrance of your driveway

This allows snow to enter the cleared area, instead of blocking the driveway



DON'T FORGET!

Snow must be cleared from sidewalks within 24 hours of the end of a snow storm!

REMINDERS FOR RESIDENTS

BE CAREFUL WITH FROZEN PIPES!

During the coldest months of the year, residents are reminded to be careful with frozen pipes!


Residents should never use open flame to thaw frozen pipes.



If a small section is frozen, a hair dryer can be used.



If a large section is frozen, the entire space should be slowly warmed using space heaters if needed, keeping them 3 feet from any combustibles.
